Solemnity of Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession

You are invited to participate in the first annual Eucharistic Procession for parishioners in the Tri-Cities area of Southeast Washington on Saturday, June 5, 2021. The procession will start at 9:00 am after the 8:00 am Mass at St. Patrick Parish in Pasco. The procession route, which is approximately 1-mile long, includes pauses in Pasco's Memorial Park for prayer and Adoration. The procession will end back at the parish for Benediction and final blessing. Participation from your parish and associations of the faithful will help make this a celebration of the source and summit of our Catholic life and a powerful witness of Christ's love.

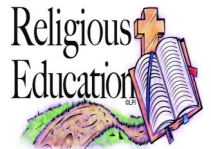
