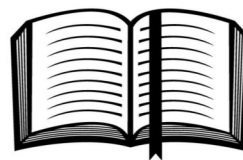

The Newman Connection is a program that connects the student to the "Catholic presence" when he/she arrives on campus. By furnishing the Campus Minister names and addresses of Catholic students coming to their school, the Campus Minister has an opportunity to send personal invitations to the students to visit their facility when they arrive on campus. Should there be no Newman Center nor Catholic Campus Ministry at their school, students will receive information about a nearby parish.
