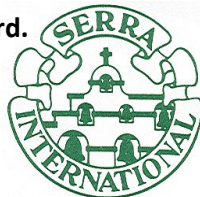

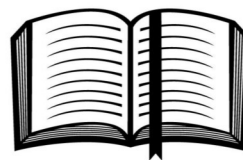


St. Joseph is Hiring !
