
A NOTE FROM ST. SERRA CLUB OF TRI CITIES

### CELEBRATING MARRIAGE AT ST. JOSEPH PARISH

The loving union of husband and wife speaks of family values and also God's values. **Marriage Preparation** After you initially contact the Parish Office expressing interest in celebrating your wedding at St. Joseph, you will be contacted by the priest to arrange to meet at the Parish Office at a mutually-convenient time. Only after this first meeting will you be able to reserve a date for 2023. Keep in mind that the preparation length is approximately six months. No weddings are scheduled during Lent or Advent. The times available on Saturdays are 11:00 am and 2:00 pm. **Renewal of Wedding Vows** Many parishioners ask to renew their wedding vows from time to time as a reminder of the importance of the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony and because they realize the significance of a God-centered marriage. These celebrations usually take place on an important wedding anniversary such as the 25th, 40th, or 50th, but vows may be renewed at any time.
