(Canon Law 587 & 2) If you are a parishioner who attends St. Joseph and would like to baptize your child in another Parish, you will need a letter from the Pastor of St. Joseph giving you permission to do so. If you are not a St. Joseph parishioner and want to baptize your child in this Parish, you need to get permission from your Pastor to baptize your child here. The parents and sponsors must attend a class before the Baptism of the child.

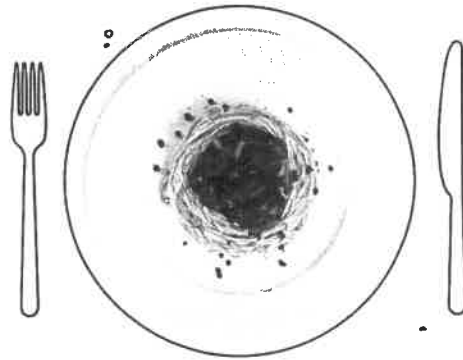

First Reconciliation & First Communion

- Preparation begins in first grade
- 2-year program– weekly classes (must attend consecutively). Regular attendance for Mass and classes, as well as active participation in class is necessary.
- Must provide baptism certificate at time of registration even if baptized at St. Joseph.
- Must register their child each year.
- \$50 per student to cover book and materials



Ongoing Faith Formation (Post Communion)

- For children and youth who have already received their first communion.

RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation for Children/teens)

- Unbaptized children ages 7 and up.
- 2 year program– weekly classes (must attend consecutively).
- This program has supplementary classes for the students, Parents, and Godparents.
- Regular attendance for Mass and classes, as well as active participation in class is necessary. All students who are ready and prepared will receive the sacraments at the Easter Vigil in their second academic year of classes.
- Must provide state issued birth certificate at time of registration.
- \$50 per student to cover book and materials.

Confirmation Program

- Students must be in grades 7-10 grade and have previously received the First Communion (Eucharist).
- Please provide copy of the baptism and first communion certificate at time of registration.
- 2-year program – weekly classes (must attend consecutively).
- Regular attendance for Mass and classes, as well as active participation in class is necessary.
- Must attend a retreat in the second year of preparation.
- 15 hours of Christian service must be completed each year.
- Registration is required each year.
- \$50 per student to cover book and materials.

2024 Quinceañera Program

A Quinceañera is a joyous celebration of a young woman — a Quinceañera— reaching the age of 15.

The celebration is a way of acknowledging that the young woman has reached maturity and is ready to take on additional responsibilities. Most importantly, the celebration reaffirms her religious faith and the traditional virtues of the Catholic family.

In order to celebrate a Quinceañera at St. Joseph Church, the following requirements must be met:

- The Quinceañeras parents must be previously registered (provide your envelope # at moment of making registration) in the parish and be actively attending Sunday Mass.
- The Quinceañera must have previously received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). Please present a copy of the Quinceañeras First Communion certificate at the moment of registration.
- Beginning May 1, 2023, please register her for the Confirmation program at the Parish Office if she has not received Confirmation.
- As part of the formation process, the Quinceañera will need to attend youth group on a weekly basis and six supplementary classes.
- The Quinceañera is required to attend a weekend youth retreat.
- Parent and Quinceañera service hours: The Quinceañera must complete 20 service hours and the parents must complete 10.

Registration & Reservations will only take place on August 1, 2023 thru December of 2023 at the parish office. Reservations for 2024 will not be accepted after this date. Reservations will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

All Masses for Quinceañeras are all held in the small church on the fourth Saturday of the month at 11:00 am and 2:00 pm. For more information, contact the parish office at 509-

Renewal of Wedding Vows

Many parishioners ask to renew their wedding vows from time to time as a reminder of the importance of the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony, and they realize the significance of a God centered marriage. These celebrations usually take place on an important wedding anniversary such as the 25th, 40th, or 50th, but vows may be renewed at anytime.

Option 1: regular Mass time (call 2 weeks prior)

Option 2: within a Private Mass (1 year to 6 months prior)

For 2024 we will begin to take reservations on September 1st.

CELEBRATING MARRIAGE AT ST. JOSEPH PARISH

“And the two shall become one”

For Catholics, the Sacrament of Marriage, or Holy Matrimony, is a public sign that one gives oneself totally to this other person. It is also a public statement about God: the loving union of husband and wife speaks of family values and also God’s values.

MARRIAGE PREPARATION

After you initially contact the parish office expressing interest in celebrating your wedding at St. Joseph, you will be contacted by the priest to arrange to meet at the parish office at a mutually convenient time. Only after having this first meeting will you be able to reserve a date for 2024. Keep in mind that the preparation length is approximately six months.

No weddings are scheduled during Lent or advent. The times available on Saturday are 11:00 am and 2:00 pm.

Update: Reservations will now take place September 1st due to the new priest assignments.

INFANT BAPTISMS

Thank you for choosing life! The Lord has blessed you with the gift of a child and now you have made the important decision to have your child baptized in the Catholic Church.

Baptisms at our parish are celebrated in groups on the third Saturday of the month (except for lent and advent).

Before a date is set all paperwork needs to be completed & turned in with required documents (at the same time) one month prior.

TO REGISTER FOR A BAPTISM

- *Pick up a registration packet at the parish office during office hours.*
- Provide a copy of infant’s birth certificate (must be a legal copy from the state, not a certificate from the hospital)
- There is to be only one male godparent or one female godparent or one of each. *Complete guidelines included in the registration packet.*
- Godparents must submit a copy of their confirmation certificate.
- Parents & Godparents must attend the Baptism class in person.
- Suggested donation of \$50.00 per child (non refundable).

If you are not a parishioner and want to baptize your child in this Parish, you will a letter from your parish pastor granting you permission for your child to be baptized at St. Joseph Parish.

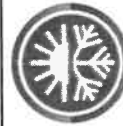
