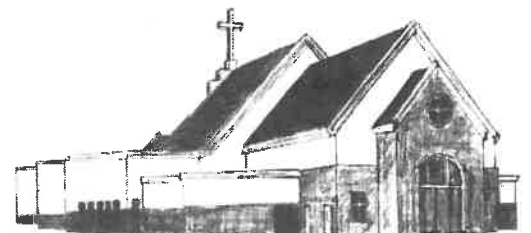

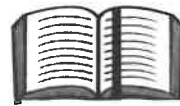
A NOTE FROM SERRA CLUB OF TRI CITIES
