Just a few years ago, Rosa hit bottom. Depression and anxiety had taken over her life and hope felt beyond reach. "I was at the point where I felt I had all the right reasons to end my life. I felt like I had nothing going for me," she says.

Thankfully, Rosa found the help she needed at Catholic Charities. Therapy combined with medication was the path that led Rosa to a new life, one full of hope. Once stable, she landed a job at a local thrift store and worked her way up to store manager. She met Eddie, they married, and are now the proud parents of a beautiful baby girl. "She's my everything. I thank God every day for her," Rosa says.



The help Rosa received at Catholic Charities was not only a lifeline for herself; it gave her the knowledge and skills to raise her daughter with the tools she needs to live a stable life.

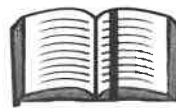

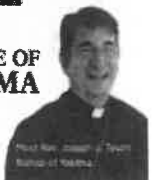
