

Requirements to register your children Families must be registered and active at St. Joseph Parish.

Parish Office: Monday- Wednesday 9:30 am - 12:00 pm y 1:00 - 3:30 pm

NOTE: Even if your children have received sacraments here, they need to request the certificates and submit them at the time of registration.

Rite of Christian Initiation: Program to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist) for youth and children over 7 years old. Provide the birth certificate at the time of registration.

• Provide the birth certificate and Baptism certificate to receive Confirmation and the Eucharist (only for youth and those in the seventh grade).

Must register every year.

The preparation required to receive the sacraments is 2 consecutive years.

Attendance at class every Wednesday, Mass every weekend and Holy Days of Obligation-Blue Envelopes and Mass transit cards are required to be turned in weekly.

All candidates must complete 30 hours of community service 15 hours per year these hours are divided into 3 categories.

5 hours of parish events

5 hours community events

5 hours of liturgy: helping during Mass as an altar boy, in the choir or as an usher.

All candidates will receive a form to keep track of their hours.

The form must be submitted with the required signature. Parents are NOT eligible to sign this form.

Students who are prepared will receive the sacraments at the Easter Vigil in his second year of formation.

Note: A godfather or godmother who is single or married in the Catholic Church is required. The godfather or godmother must provide a copy of the sacrament of Confirmation or Marriage.

Sacrament of the Eucharist (First Communion):

Submit the birth certificate and baptism certificate at the time of registration.

Registration is done every year, \$50 for the book and materials.

Preparation to receive the sacrament begins in the first grade.

The preparation required to receive the sacrament is 2 consecutive years. Attendance at class every Saturday and Mass every weekend.

Note: Godparents are NOT required for the sacrament of the Eucharist.

Post Communion (continuing formation):

For children who have already received the sacrament of first communion.

Registration is done every year, \$50 for the book and materials.

Confirmation Program:

Students must be in grades 7-11th and have previously received first communion.

Provide the baptism certificate and first communion at the time of registration.

Registration is done every year, \$50 for the book and materials.

The preparation required to receive the sacrament is 2 consecutive years.

Attendance at class every Saturday and Mass every weekend.

All candidates must complete 30 hours of community service 15 hours per year these hours are divided into 3 categories.

5 hours of parish events.

5 hours community events. 5 hours of liturgy: helping during Mass as an altar boy, in the choir or as an usher.

All candidates will receive a form to keep track of their hours. The form must be submitted with the required signature. Parents are NOT eligible to sign this form. Service hours are to be done outside of the family home.
