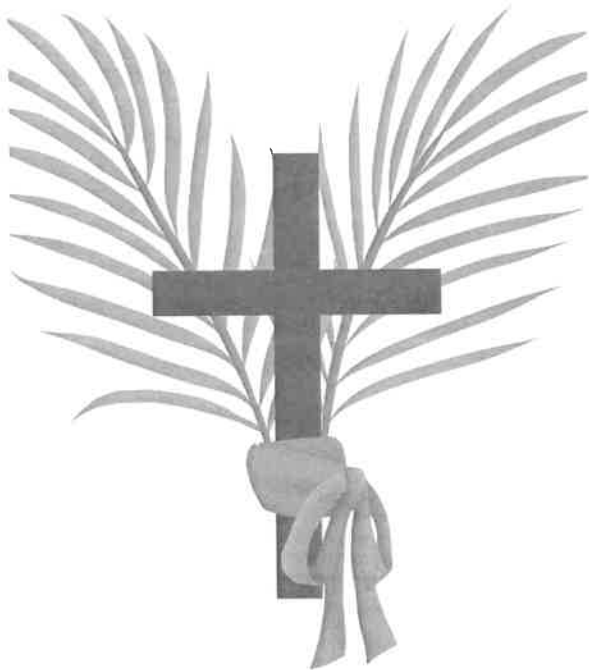

Many years ago, I lived in Renton, Washington and several of us went to coffee after morning Mass on most Tuesdays. One of our group, told me he did a communion service at an Assisted Living residence and would like to have a backup in case he was sick, on vacation, or could not do the service for some reason. I told him that I was sure this was not a ministry for me, but he asked me go with him on Sunday and if it wasn't for me, he would find someone else.

On Thursday, his wife called me and asked me to pick up the communion kit. I was puzzled and asked why. Because, she said, her husband died the day before while saying his rosary!

So, I picked up the communion kit and made my way to the Assisted Living residence that Sunday, with doubt and apprehension. Convinced that at the first opportunity, I would meet with the person in our parish who oversaw Ministry to the Homebound and tell her this was not for me.

To my surprise, I found that I enjoyed the experience and instead of quitting before I got started, I continued to do this ministry for years.
