All parents and Godparents are required to participate in pre-Baptism classes. Once parents register, the dates for the in-person classes will be reserved.

Godparents: If there are two Godparents, one must be male and the other female. Godparents must be practicing Catholics, 16 years of age or older, and must have received the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Communion, and Confirmation.


