WHAT IS A JUBILEE YEAR?

A Jubilee Year is a sacred time in the Church, occurring only every 25 years, fostering holiness through reconciliation and communion. Jubilee Year 2025, themed "Pilgrims of Hope," offers special graces through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, local pilgrimages, and the Jubilee Indulgence.

WHAT IS A JUBILEE INDULGENCE?

The Jubilee indulgence is a traditional part of a Jubilee year. It is a plenary indulgence which can be applied either to yourself or to your deceased loved ones. The ordinary conditions for obtaining the Jubilee indulgence are to receive the sacraments of **Reconciliation** and **Eucharist**, to pray for the intentions of the Holy Father, and to make a pilgrimage locally.

LIFE NIGHTS (YOUTH GROUP)

LIFE TEEN

QUINCEAÑERA PROGRAM 2025-2026 (15TH B-DAY CELEBRATION)

A Quinceañera is a joyous celebration of a young woman — a Quinceañera— reaching the age of 15.

The celebration is a way of acknowledging that the young woman has reached maturity (not a sacrament) and is ready to take on additional responsibilities.

To celebrate a Quinceañera at St. Joseph Church, the following requirements must be met:

- The Quinceañera's parents must be registered as parishioners at our parish and be actively attending Sunday Mass.
- The Quinceañera must have previously received the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). Please present a copy of the Quinceañera's First Communion certificate at the moment of registration.
- As part of the formation process, the Quinceañera will need to attend youth group (Life Nights) weekly (Aug. 29, 2025— June 2026) and six supplementary classes in the fall.
- The Quinceañera is required to attend a weekend youth retreat (Pre Easter Youth Retreat 2026).
- Parent and Quinceañera service hours: The Quinceañera must complete 20 service hours, and the parents must complete 10.

Registration and reservations will only be accepted from **August 1 to 22, 2025**, at the Parish Office with Nancy T.

Reservations are made on a first-come, first-served basis. All Quinceañera Masses are held on the fourth Saturday of each month. Please note that we do not offer blessings at any other time or location.

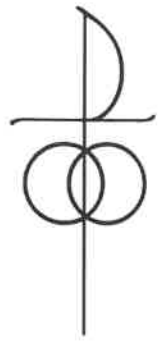

Fr. Ricardo Villarreal has scheduled an initial interview meeting for **Monday, July 7th, at 5:30 pm** on the second floor of the parish office.

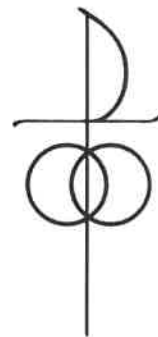
During this initial meeting, the priest will determine if you and your fiancé are free to marry in the Church (i.e., confirm that there are no canonical impediments).

The Importance of Trying Before Making a Decision

Many years ago, I resided in Renton, Washington, where a few of us would often gather for coffee after morning Mass on Tuesdays. One member of our group mentioned that he conducted a communion service at an Assisted Living facility and needed a backup in case he was ill, on vacation, or unable to perform the service for any reason. I expressed my belief that this ministry wasn't for me, but he invited me to join him on a Sunday. He assured me that if it didn't resonate with me, he would find someone else.

Then, on Thursday, his wife reached out and asked me to collect the communion kit. Confused, I inquired why. She explained, "Because her husband passed away the day before while saying his rosary!" So, I picked up the communion kit and headed to the Assisted Living residence that Sunday, filled with doubt and apprehension. I was determined that as soon as possible, I would speak to the person in our parish responsible for Ministry to the Homebound and inform her that this wasn't right for me.

To my surprise, I actually enjoyed the experience. Instead of quitting before I even began, I continued this ministry for many years. You truly never know what you might discover until you give something a try!
