Bishop Joseph Tyson's Letter

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Soon, our diocese will take up a collection for the **Pontifical Good Friday Collection** on **April 3**. Pope Leo has asked our parish to support the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which helps Christians in the Holy Land. Through the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, you stand in solidarity with the Church in the Holy Land as a witness of peace, supporting Catholics there in parishes and schools, maintaining Christian shrines and caring for refugees in the Holy Land.

Fully **100 %** of donations will go towards this collection. A portion of your contributions are allocated to educational and ecclesial projects in the Middle East. The rest of the funds collected in the United States and other countries around the world support ministries and programs in the Holy Land.

Thanks to last year's Pontifical Good Friday Collection:

- 24 parishes and 3 academic institutions were supported
- A home in Bethlehem was provided for 28 children from situations of domestic violence •
More than 500 university scholarships were awarded
- 18 schools remained open, serving over 10,000 students (pre-K through grade 12) •
53 friars in formation for the priesthood were supported
- 640 homes/apartments were restored and maintained for Christian families
- Over 9,000 families received weekly food assistance
- More than 1,000 workers were employed in a time of scarce job opportunities
- 65 holy shrines connected to Jesus, the Apostles, and the prophets were preserved •
Restoration work continued at the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher, the holiest place on Earth




